































































Grade Band Option









Same Sites Option


Do you think it is a good idea or bad idea to replace all 3 of the current primary schools with new kindergarten through grade 4 school buildings that would all be located in the same locations?




















VERMONT - Conceptual First Floor Plan







VERMONT - Conceptual First Floor Plan Wyoming Primary Facilities Master Plan

















































TEMPORARY SOFTBALL FIELD LOCATION







SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND ISSUE

A property tax levy for a specific dollar amount to be borrowed to finance construction.

The District sells bond (issues debt) and receives the revenue for the project.

Over the next 37 years, property taxes are assessed annually and collected by the District to pay the principal and interest payments on the debt.



How are the taxes assessed annually?

Mills

A term used to express tax rates: 1/10 of 1% = .001 OR \$1 per \$1000 of assessed value

Assessed Valuation

35% of the property's appraised market value

\$100,000 market value = \$35,000 assessed valuation

Millage is calculated on assessed valuation

1 mill would cost the owner of a \$100,000 home = \$35 per year

WYOMING CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PREVIOUS BOND ISSUES

Wyoming City Schools has 2 bond issues currently outstanding:



Wyoming High School 1998 Issue – 3.36 mills \$24,000,000 from May 1998 voted at 8.2 mills Final payment December 2024



Wyoming Middle School 2012 Issue - 2.64 mills \$25,037,114 from March 2012 voted at 4.79 mills

FINANCE

COST TO HOMEOWNERS

A new \$72.5 million bond issue for Wyoming Primary Schools is estimated to be a 7.98 mill tax levy.



Annual tax increase on a \$100,000 home for 7.98 mills = \$279.21

WHS bond paid off on December 31, 2024 saving 3.36 mills = \$117.60

Net cost is 4.62 mills = \$161.61

PROPOSED BOND ISSUE

Majority Affirmative Vote is Necessary for Passage

Shall bonds be issued by the Board of Education of the Wyoming City School District, County of Hamilton, Ohio, for the purpose of new construction, improvements, renovations, and additions to school facilities, including the construction of three new primary schools, and providing equipment, furnishings, and site development and improvements, and all necessary appurtenances therefor, including modern technology and safety, security and accessibility measures, as well as land acquisition and capitalized interest, in the principal amount of Seventy-Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$72,500,000), to be repaid annually over a maximum period of thirty seven (37) years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 7.98 mills, for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$279 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, commencing in 2024, first due in 2025, to pay the annual debt charge on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?
